

## **Guy Gosselin - nominated by the Canadian Society for Civil Engineering**

*Guy Gosselin has 26 years of engineering practical experience and 17 years of managerial experience at the National Research Council Institute for Research in Construction. He is currently the Manager – Industry Liaison and Outreach (ILO). At NRC, Guy led ILO's contributions to the development of NRC's new Virtual Store and established a more productive liaison with important stakeholder groups. He also supported the marketing of National Construction Codes and acted as the Institute's privacy coordinator. In 2001, Guy created InfraGuide, a partnership between Infrastructure Canada, the Federation of Canadian Municipalities and the National Research Council of Canada. InfraGuide is a series of best practice reports that municipalities apply to solve infrastructure problems and a broad network where engineers, technologists, researchers, elected officials and others share their Canadian experience and knowledge on infrastructure issues.*
