



Dick Frey - nominated by the Canadian Society for Senior Engineers

Dick Frey is the retired Managing Director Utilities of the ATCO Group. He has made outstanding contributions to the Electrical Systems of Alberta, Northwest Territories and the Yukon. During his working career he led and participated in the building of the Sheerness Generating Station and the back to back DC tie between Alberta and Saskatchewan. For some fifteen years he was a member of the Alberta Electric Utilities Planning Council whose mandate was the planning of generation and transmission additions for the province of Alberta.

Following the Alberta Government's decision in the mid-1990s to deregulate the generation and sales of electricity he was heavily involved in the restructuring of the provincial industry and ATCO Electric. Following retirement from the ATCO Group Dick served as a board member and co-chair of the Edmonton and Area Child and Family Services Authority for seven years.
