



Christopher Yip - nominated by Canadian Society for Chemical Engineering

Christopher Yip is a Professor in the Department of Chemical Engineering & Applied Chemistry and the Director of the Institute of Biomaterials & Biomedical Engineering at the University of Toronto. An outstanding teacher and researcher, he has conducted innovative research of the biophysical characteristics of single molecules. His work has been cited more than 2500 times.

Professor Yip is a member of the CIHR Institute of Genetics Advisory Board and has made extensive contributions to CIHR, NSERC and the U.S. National Institutes of Health. He was the first recipient of Molecular Imaging's Outstanding Young Biological Scanning Probe Microscopy Investigator of the Year Award. Since that time, he has been honoured with a Premier's Research Excellence Award and two teaching awards.

Professor Yip is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. He held a Canada Research Chair in Molecular Imaging from 2000-2010.
