



Robin Drew - nominated by the Canadian Society for Mechanical Engineering

Robin Drew is the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science at Concordia University. Prior to taking on this challenging leadership role, he was a professor in the Department of Mining and Materials Engineering at McGill for more than 20 years. In addition to his strong research on materials engineering, he has also brought advancement through his leadership as a Department Chairman as then as a Dean of Engineering. He brought McGill's traditional Metallurgical, Minerals and Mining Department into the 'Materials Age' with coverage of Aerospace and lightweight materials, biomaterials and non-materials. At Concordia he is leading the Engineering Faculty to more prominence as both an engineering

education centre and a research engine.

Robin is a Fellow of the Canadian Institute of Mining, Metallurgy and Petroleum, the Canadian Society, the Canadian Academy of Engineering, the Institute of Mining, Minerals and Materials (UK), and is an Overseas Fellow of Churchill College, University of Cambridge (UK).
