



Clément Fortin - nominated by the Canadian Society for Mechanical Engineering

Dr Clément Fortin is President and Chief Executive Officer of the Consortium for Research and Innovation for Aerospace in Quebec. Dr Fortin was previously Chair of the Department of Mechanical Engineering at École Polytechnique de Montréal from 2005 until 2010, and has been a Professor at the institution since 1987.

His research contributions have focused on the PLM field, including product and manufacturing process development, engineering change management, virtual environments for product development, computer-aided tolerancing and product in-use information synthesis for design and integration with PLM technologies.

He received the SAE Teetor Award in 1985 for his academic contributions as a young professor and École Polytechnique Chief Executive Officer's Excellence Award in 1991. In 2008, he was named Pratt & Whitney Canada Research Fellow and in 2011 he received the title of Fellow of the Canadian Society of Mechanical Engineering
