Leonard Lye is the Associate Dean for Graduate Studies and Professor of Civil Engineering in the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science at the Memorial University of Newfoundland. He is a Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Engineering, the Canadian Society for Civil Engineering, and Engineers Canada. His research interests involve environmental statistics, design and analysis of experiments, hydrology, and hydraulics. He has produced over 140 academic publications including 46 refereed journal papers and one book. He is also the inventor of 5 engineering educational devices and software.

Leonard has been recognized for his exemplary achievements and leadership as educator, researcher and administrator. Particularly he has made significant contributions to the Canadian civil engineering education and profession over the past 30 years. He has received many awards and honours including:
