Dr. Faisal Khan has made significant contributions to the fields of offshore safety and risk engineering, asset integrity management, and risk-based integrity assessment and management of infrastructure. He is a Professor of Process Engineering and a Tier 1 Canada Research Chair in Offshore Safety and Risk Engineering at Memorial University. He regularly advises multinational oil and gas industries and regulatory agencies on the issue of safety and asset integrity. He has also served as a safety and risk advisor to the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador, as well as Lloyd's Register EMEA, SBM, ABS, Qatargas and others.

Faisal is a recipient of Memorial University's President's Award for Outstanding Research and the President's Award for Outstanding Graduate Student Supervision, and the CSChE Process Safety Management Award. He has co-authored 7 books and over 500 journal and conference papers on safety, risk, and reliability engineering. He is an editorial board member for the journal Process Safety and Environmental Protection and for the Journal of Loss Prevention in Process Industries.

Faisal is also a Fellow of the Canadian Society for Chemical Engineering (CSChE).
