Mr. Leslie Cherwenuk – A Member of CSEM

Mr. Cherwenuk graduated with honours in Civil Engineering from the University of Saskatchewan, and has completed numerous courses in Engineering Management and Decision and Risk Analysis. He is currently Manager of North American Pipeline Ventures for Trans-Canada Pipelines Ltd. (NNA Gas Transmission Ltd.).

Mr. Cherwenuk was with the engineering group of Nova Gas Transmission Ltd. from 1981 to 1994, subsequently becoming until 1998 Manager of Project Development for Nova Pipeline Ventures. During that period his duties varied from project execution for compressor stations and office locations through project management and overseeing facilities planning for all gas transmission components. His career continued as a business specialist overseeing initiatives to position Nova Gas competitively in the gas transmission area. He is currently overseeing new business opportunities which include:

- Development of Trans Canada's first integrated strategy for the North east Region
- Trans Canada's 2000 Business Plan for Northern Development
- Feasibility of developing McKenzie Delta Gas, which of course led to Trans Canada establishing
 Northern Development as a fundamental business strategy.

With the business and management acumen that Mr. Cherwenuk possesses his interest in the development of the CSEM in Calgary has been providential. He has been Secretary Treasurer for the last 15 years, and is one of the key members credited with the revival and continuing development of the CSEM – and the EIC is proud of his accomplishments.
