

Zhizhang (David) Chen- nominated by IEEE Canada

Professor Chen has been a faculty member with the Faculty of Engineering of Dalhousie University since 1993 and is currently the Head of the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering. He has been active in teaching, research and professional services. He has made exceptional contributions as a scholar and educator in computational electromagnetics and RF/microwave engineering, time-domain modeling and simulation techniques and ultra-wide band technologies and seminal advances in unconditionally stable modelling schemes commercialized by industry.

Other recognitions include the Association of Professional Engineers of Nova Scotia (APENS) 2005 Engineering Award, the 2006 teaching excellence award from Dalhousie Student Union, the 2006 Professor of the Year in Electrical and Computer Engineering of Dalhousie University and the 2007 Dalhousie Faculty of Engineering Dean's Research Excellence Award. He has been elevated to Fellow of the IEEE and a Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Engineering.
