

EIC Fellow Jean-Guy René

Jean-Guy René is a Fellow of the CSSE. He joined Hydro Quebec as President of the James Bay Energy where he led the group completing the second phase of development of this project. This included over 5000 MW of plant in five different locations. He then became President of Hydro Quebec International, responsible for Hydro Quebec operations in Australia, Central and South America. Following this he acted as President of Transmission line companies in Peru and Chile, companies to which he still provides management and engineering support.

Jean-Guy is the immediate past President of the Canadian Society of Senior Engineers and sits on several community boards and management committees. He is also an expert advisor to Infrastructure Quebec on transportation matters and a director of the Eden Foundation.

For his contributions to Electrical Power Generation and Transmission Systems in Canada, South America and Africa, we now pay tribute to Jean-Guy René with this honor.
