Tony Bennett has been a driving force in the development and advancement of dam safety practices in Canada and internationally. He has lead the development of guidelines and practices for public safety around dams and for emergency management around dams both at OPG and the CDA. The Guidelines on Public Safety Around Dams published by the CDA in 2011 are the most comprehensive set of practice documents available and have been widely adopted by professionals in Canada and internationally.

Tony's expertise and leadership are sought after, and he has served and continues to serve on many external review panels and committees. Recognizing his contributions to advancing dam safety in Canada, the CDA awarded him the Inge Award of Merit in 2012. He is a long-time member of CDA and devoted significant time to the CDA serving on the Board of Directors and two terms as President.

Tony also served as President of the Engineering Institute of Canada in 2010-2012.
