David Berger is currently President of the Lamus Group Inc., a management consulting firm offering strategic planning, process engineering, information systems, and organizational design consulting. He has more than four decades of superb engineering and professional services that have contributed significantly to the growth and development of the manufacturing, service, government, financial, and not-for-profit sectors.

David has led countless multi-million-dollar projects across Canada ranging from process/systems design for a major global utility, to strategic planning and organizational design for many municipalities, to leading process design work resulting in \$400+ million for a major financial institution. He has made significant contributions both in industry and in academia. This includes extensive teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels, supervising numerous student projects and research initiatives, publishing more than 450 articles and white papers globally, and presenting at countless seminars, webinars and conferences.

David has also offered support and leadership on a voluntary basis to many professional and not-for-profit organizations.
