Dr. Jianbing Li is a Professor in the School of Engineering at the University of Northern British Columbia (UNBC). He is a Fellow of the Canadian Society for Civil Engineering and of the Canadian Society of Senior Engineers.

His research activities focus on environmental engineering by addressing contemporary environmental challenges such as how to manage hazardous waste and chemical spills in natural environments as well as how to address water quality and security issues in small and remote communities. Dr. Li has produced more than 300 publications in international journals and conference proceedings, including over 210 refereed journal papers.

His publications have made valuable and significant contributions to both methodologies and their application to real-world studies. He has trained over 70 graduate students (PhD and MSc), postdoctoral fellows, research associates, and research assistants. He served as a guest editor or associate editor or editorial board member for over ten international journals. Dr. Li served and chaired many scientific committees and conferences and has provided extraordinary services to the engineering profession.

In 2023, he received CSCE's Dr. Albert E. Berry Medal recognizing his outstanding contribution to the field of environmental engineering in Canada.
